



1. The University of Toronto Scarborough Alumni Admission Awards seek to recognize and encourage both high quality academic work (a minimum B plus average is required) and participation in non-classroom activities which indicate a concern for the quality of life in the school or community. Examples of activities which would be given serious consideration for these scholarships include: working as a volunteer with a community agency or with service projects organized by ethnic groups, churches, ratepayer organizations, etc.; working on projects initiated while holding office in secondary school organizations; working in a leadership capacity in sports or arts activities.
2. The University of Toronto Scarborough Alumni Admission Awards are awarded annually to students graduating from an Ontario secondary school program or equivalent secondary school program who are offered admission to U of T Scarborough. Secondary school students who are candidates for admission to U of T Scarborough in the year in which they are completing their university entrance requirements are eligible to apply. There are **two** awards valued at **\$1,500** each.
3. Each application must include the names of at least two and not more than four persons from whom a written recommendation on behalf of the applicant is required. At least one letter should be from a member of the teaching staff and at least one letter should be from a member of the community (non-relative).
4. The deadline for receipt of the application and letters of reference is **March 2, 2012**.

**Notes:**

The Selection Committee shall consist of representatives of the University of Toronto Scarborough and the University of Toronto Scarborough Alumni Association.

The scholarship recipients will be notified by letter, mailed from UTSC (normally by the end of April). The award shall be credited towards the recipient's tuition account in September. In the event that an applicant chooses to enrol at an institution other than at the U of T Scarborough, he or she will forfeit the award.
