



1. The University of Toronto Scarborough GRADitude Legacy Award seeks to recognize a student who had made outstanding contributions to his/her community. The recipient of this award must be able to demonstrate leadership qualities in his/her volunteer role. Special consideration will be given to students who can demonstrate involvement with multiple community organizations and/or who can show involvement consistently throughout their high school years, and progression in their volunteer involvement.
2. The GRADitude Legacy Award is awarded annually to a student who graduated/is graduating from an Ontario secondary school program or equivalent secondary school program who is offered admission to the University of Toronto Scarborough. Students who may have taken an extended period of time after graduating from high school to volunteer/work towards the betterment of a community before applying to the University of Toronto Scarborough are also eligible for consideration. There is one award valued at approximately **\$900**.
3. Each application must include the names of two persons from whom a written recommendation on behalf of the applicant is required. Note: at least one letter should be from a member of the community (non-relative).
4. The deadline for receipt of the application and letters of reference is **March 2, 2012**.

Notes:

The Selection Committee shall consist of representatives of the University of Toronto Scarborough Council, GRADitude committee Chair(s) and two to three individuals from the GRADitude volunteer committee.

The scholarship recipient will be notified by letter, normally mailed with the Offer of Admission. The award shall be credited towards the recipient's tuition account in September. In the event that an applicant chooses to enrol at an institution other than at U of T Scarborough, he or she will forfeit the award.
