



1. The John H. Youson Entrance Award in Biological Sciences recognizes a student entering first year in programs in Biological Sciences (including Co-op Cell and Molecular Biology) who has high academic achievement (a minimum of an A average/80% is required) and who has demonstrated a high level of involvement in extra-curricular activities in the school or community. Examples of activities which would be given serious consideration for this scholarship include: working as a volunteer with a community agency or with service projects organized by ethnic groups, churches, ratepayer organizations, etc.; working on projects initiated while holding office in secondary school organizations; working in a leadership capacity in sports or arts activities.
2. The John H. Youson Entrance Award in Biological Sciences is awarded annually to students graduating from an Ontario secondary school program or equivalent secondary school program. Secondary school students who are candidates for admission to U of T Scarborough in the year in which they are completing their university entrance requirements are eligible to apply. Applicants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents of Canada, residents of Ontario and must demonstrate financial need. There is **one** award valued at approximately **\$1,500**.
3. Complete the University of Toronto Advance Planning for Students (UTAPS) application to show financial information. This application can only be completed on-line at the following location: **www.adm.utoronto.ca/utaps** The deadline for UTAPS application submission is **March 2, 2012**. (Note that other award applications may have an earlier UTAPS deadline in February.)
4. Each application must include the name of one person from whom a written recommendation on behalf of the applicant is required.
5. The deadline for receipt of the application and letter of reference is **March 2, 2012**.

Notes:

The Selection Committee shall consist of representatives of the University of Toronto Scarborough Council and representatives from the Department of Biological Sciences.

The scholarship recipient will be notified by letter, mailed from UTSC (normally by the end of April). The award shall be credited towards the recipient's tuition account in September. In the event that an applicant chooses to enrol at an institution other than at U of T Scarborough, he or she will forfeit the award.
